    - Good Food Procurement Policy
    - Small Farms Municipal Ordinances
    - Market Access Barriers
  - Attend municipal meetings for potential joint actions
- Food Plan Projects Support 25%
  - Support Wake County Cooperative Extension Americorps VISTA volunteers in data assessment/mapping for projects such as:
    - Mobile market locations and local food access points
    - Communal gardens
    - Community health worker
  - Assist CAFN Project Implementation outlined at the 2023 All CAFN Gathering
- CAFN Communications and Outreach 40%
  - Develop monthly newsletters on CAFN activity and opportunities
  - o Recruit of diverse community members and partners to CAFN circles
  - Maintain CAFN Communications and website promotion
  - Assist in planning & implementation of quarterly CAFN food plan gatherings
  - Facilitate best practice webinars for resilient local food systems
